COVID 19 protective measures at the Faculty include:

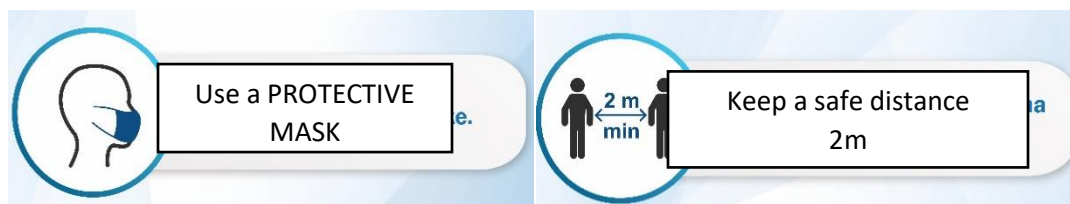
- It is necessary to measure the body temperature daily. If it is higher than 37.2C, it is necessary to stay at your accommodation and contact a doctor or COVID-19 infirmary or a territorially responsible epidemiologist: <https://www.koronavirus.hr/important-phone-numbers/152.> ). All guest students of the Faculty received an *Information package* with the contact details of their doctor. The same applies in case of symptoms of acute respiratory infection (cough, sore throat, fever, short breathing/difficulty or loss of smell, headache, muscle pain, indigestion problems, etc. ).
- Wearing suitable face coverings (protective mask) at all times when you are indoors and at all other times where applicable (unless you are exempt) is obligatory. This is particularly important where 2m social distancing is difficult to achieve (e.g. entering or leaving a lecture room).

We all have a part to play in keeping each other safe by showing respect and consideration for one another by implementing COVID 19 epidemiological measures.

The support from our Office continues as usual and we do welcome visitors personally but **ONLY BY PREARRANGED MEETING**, so be sure to contact us by email or phone.

Due to the global pandemic COVID 19 situation, **ALL visitors** are asked **NOT TO COME** to the *Office for International Cooperation* but rather arrange a meeting via e-mail or phone.

For our personal safety we are all asked to measure our temperature at the Entrance of the Faculty and log it in the records (desk across the Entrance door of the Faculty)
