

- THE STRONGEST TEACHING AND SCIENTIFIC INSTITUTION IN CROATIA



## **University of Zagreb**

- STUDENTS: 70.000 (40% female) ⇒ 48.5% of all students in Croatia
- about 7,900 teaching staff



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
