# *University of Zagreb*

- STUDENTS: 70.000 (40% female)  $\Rightarrow$  48.5% of all students in Croatia
- about 7,900 teaching staff
- **STUDY PROGRAMMES:**

  - 30 integrated undergraduate-graduate programmes
  - 14 vocational undergraduate programmes
