Virtual Campus Registration Guide

This is a step-by-step guide to help you register to the <u>UNIC Virtual Campus</u>, a shared platform designed to facilitate courses, joint programmes, and to connect researchers across all ten UNIC universities. The Platform's Matchmaking Algorithm allows you to easily find colleagues working on similar topics and exploring potential collaborations.

- Complete your basic information. When you select your role as a researcher, the system will require you to link your ORCiD profile by using your ORCID 16-digit iD. In case you don't have an ORCiD profile, you can create one here: <u>https://orcid.org</u>.
- Once your profile is created in the Virtual Campus, your registration will be confirmed within 24h.
 - Once your registration is confirmed (within 24h), log back in to the VC and click on the update profile button.



 In your Personal Information page, please allow your personal information to be visible by clicking on the toggle switch.



In order for your profile to be searchable in the UNIC Matchmaking Platform, you need to complete it by selecting keywords in the Research and Teaching Interests page.
