Personal Identification Number (PIN)

OIB is assigned by the Croatian Tax Administration. Apply preferably before arriving in Croatia.

OIB checklist

☐ Choose one application method:

- [Online through e-Citizens/eIDAS, if EU eligible*](#)
- At a Croatian embassy or consulate before arrival
- [In person at a Tax Administration Office in Croatia](#)

☐ Complete the OIB application form.

☐ Prepare a passport and a copy. If you do not have a passport, prepare an EU identity card or another national identity document together with proof of citizenship.

☐ Submit the application and keep the assigned OIB number for administrative procedures in Croatia.
